For Neuro-Oncology Educational Courses in the Developing World

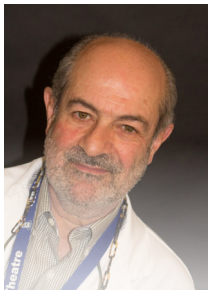
Proposal Deadline - April 30, 2017

The Society for Neuro-Oncology International Symposium Award

This initiative, introduced by Gelareh Zadeh, Chair of the SNO International Outreach Committee, was created to support a Neuro-Oncology Symposium or Educational Course in the developing world.

Proposals should outline the development of a multidisciplinary course relevant to specific regional needs in the field of neuro-oncology. A maximum \$10,000 award will be given, based on the budget presented in the proposal.

For this award cycle, the review committee would especially welcome submissions from Sub-Saharan Africa and Latin America.

- approximate dates
