About this Event

Building on the popularity of the Neuro-Tumor Club Dinner meetings traditionally held during the annual conference of the American Association of Cancer Researchers (AACR), this evening event will be an informal and stimulating exchange of late-breaking findings of specific and focused interest to investigators dedicated to brain tumor research.

The evening will begin with a Poster and Networking Reception/Bufferet Dinner, followed by short, rapid fire talks. All poster and oral presentations will be selected from submitted abstracts. The event is open to all who wish to attend, regardless of whether they wish to submit an abstract. A registration fee of \$45.00 will be charged to offset the cost of the dinner for all non-presenters.

Format

In keeping with the format of the traditional Neuro-Tumor Club events, oral presentations will short (5-slides/5-minutes) and will focus on themes of critical importance to Neuro-Oncology. A short introduction of the theme will be given by the moderators before the presentations. With only 5 slides to present, the purpose is that *“each presenter will make a seminal observation, rebut dogma, disclose a paradox, or offer to crack open a new paradigm”*. At the conclusion of each presentation we will have a short 5-minute discussion. Think *collaboration, new perspective, synergy, or a glimpse into your competitor’s lab*.

Research Themes

The organizers of the event welcome the submission of brief abstracts on any topic relating to basic and translational brain tumor research. The following categories of research are illustrative of the topics to be covered, but if there is a theme you would like to see developed, please feel free to suggest it.
