From *Neuro-Oncology* **Radiomic signatures of posterior fossa ependymoma: Molecular subgroups and risk profiles**

The risk profile for posterior fossa ependymoma (EP) depends on surgical and molecular status [Group A (PFA) versus Group B (PFB)]. While subtotal tumor resection is known to confer worse prognosis, MRI-based EP risk-profiling is unexplored. We aimed to apply machine learning strategies to link MRI-based biomarkers of high-risk EP and also to distinguish PFA from PFB. [Click here to read the full article](#).

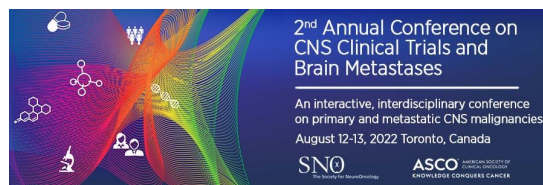
