We Need Your Vote: 2022 Board of Directors Elections



Patterns of care in adult histone mutant gliomas: results of an international survey

Histone mutant gliomas (HMG) with histone H3 K27 and G34 mutations are recognized as biologically discrete entities with distinct anatomical locations, a younger age at presentation (in comparison to the most common high grade gliomas, IDH wild type glioblastoma) and poor prognosis. There is a paucity of data regarding management of adult HMG patients and no consensus for management.
